Once the ID has been processed, students will receive an email for appointment and pick up instructions, if needed OneCard is needed before Orientation. Students attending UMB for the first time on August 18 will pick up their OneCard at Orientation.

The Barcode/One Card number is available for Online/Virtual (All) Students who may need their number for exam entrance, library access, etc. and do not require a physical One Card ID at this time.
